- India ranks first among the world's milk producing nations, achieving an annual output of 164 million tonnes during the year 2016-17.
- Indian Dairy Industry is currently pegged at USD 70 billion (Both organized & unorganized) & expected to double by 2020.
- Per capita availability of milk increased from 307 gm/day in 2013-14 to 351 gm/day in 2016-17.
- Milk production is projected to reach 200 Million tons by 2018, of which 75% will be produced for domestic consumption and 25% will be produced for export.

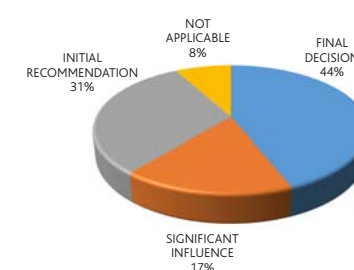

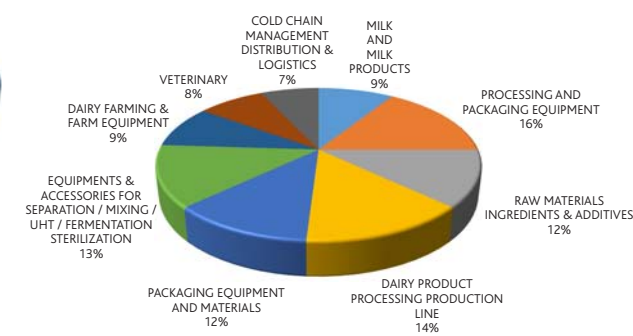
