Technological Developments in Dairy Industry

India - Worlds Largest producer of milk, accounting for around 20% of total global milk production is also the world's largest consumer of dairy products. Indian dairy industry currently pegged at USD 70 billion is expected to double by 2020.

Need of The Hour : There is a marked gradual shift of milk handling from unorganised to organised sector, hence it is most pertinent to explore and adopt new technologies and developments especially in milk production, processing, packaging and distribution. Improving raw milk quality; bacteriological as well as milk constituents; is important for increasing shelf life and value addition. Energy efficiency and reduced losses offer edge over others to remain competitive. New packing materials will help keep pace with prevailing environment friendly measures at affordable prices.

Technologies like photo pasteurization, HP technology need to be explored in the above context and Innovative biodegradable packaging solutions will address the environmental issues. Advanced technologies in supply chain management need to be adopted to maintain food safety of the product. Skilled personnel will be the backbone to implement new technologies in the industry. Hence skill development programs to meet these requirement of the industry will enable to absorb those new technologies fully.

However, new technologies will be available only after research & developments in those areas supported by the research institutions, industry and the governments.
